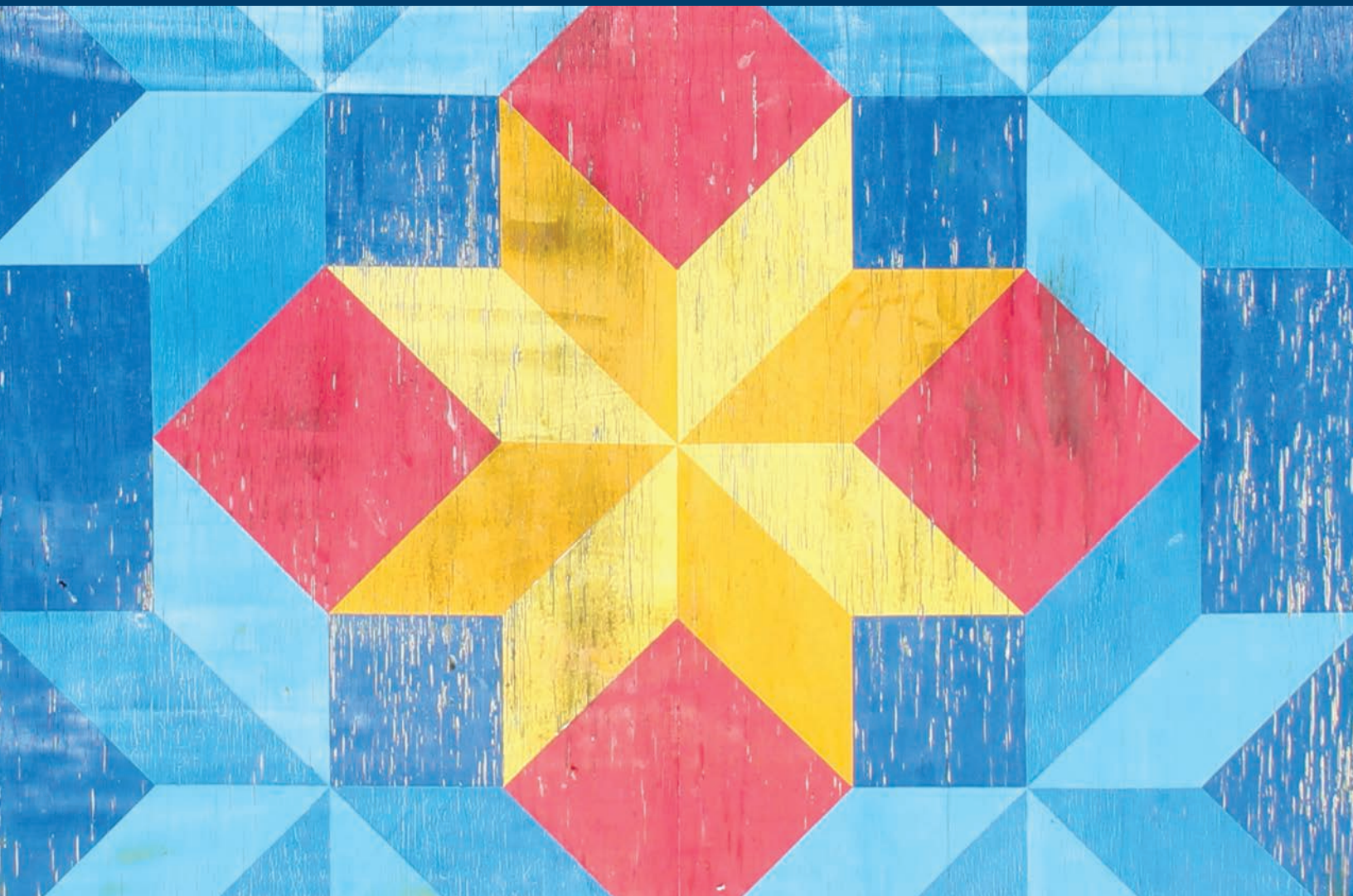

Welcome to the Chisago Lakes Barn Quilt Trail! What started in 2015 as a public art project has evolved into one of the most unique and picturesque ways to explore the Chisago Lakes area. We invite you to view our many barn quilts as you experience all our communities have to offer.

What is a Barn Quilt?

Within many cultures, the humble quilt has represented hard work, individuality, warmth, and resourcefulness. Quilts tell the story of our indigenous peoples, immigrants and pioneers. Created as a representation of this iconic artform, barn quilts are quilt block patterns, colorfully painted on wood squares of varying sizes. These quilts began to appear on farmstead barns more than 100 years ago, and many farms were known by their unique quilt pattern.

Barn Quilt History

For over 20 years, barn quilt trails have been established throughout North America, honoring the heritage of sharing local culture through quilts installed on barns and buildings. Today, over 40 quilt trails dot the landscape of the United States, representing traditional Americana.

Barn Quilts in Chisago Lakes

The Chisago Lakes Barn Quilt Trail (formerly known as the Swedish Barn Quilt Trail) owes its existence to the Chisago Lakes Area Community Foundation and a local artist named Dave Oaks.

In 2013, the Chisago Lakes Area Community Foundation (CLACF) completed its “Life is GREAT on Highway 8!” campaign, featuring brightly painted giant adirondack chairs in each of Chisago Lakes’ five towns. The goal of the chair project was to build community along the Highway 8 corridor, and the Foundation was looking for its next project. At the same time, an artist named Dave Oaks had been creating colorful barn quilts to sell at local markets. Board members from the CLACF read a story about him in the local paper and learned he was hoping to start a quilt trail here in Chisago Lakes. They reached out to Dave and the Foundation’s next project was born!

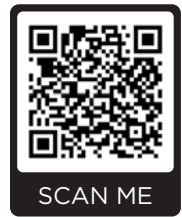

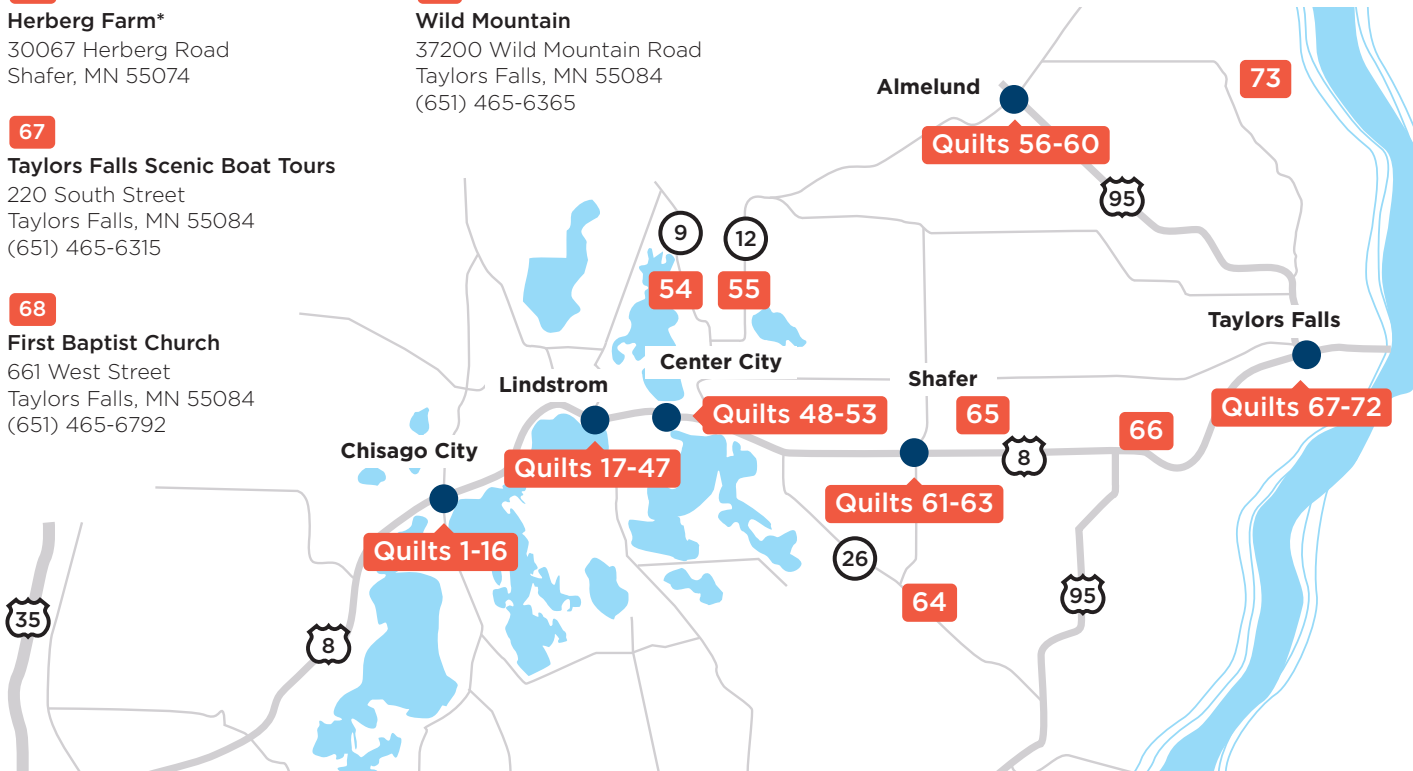

The goal of the Chisago Lakes Barn Quilt Trail was to heighten awareness of our area’s Swedish heritage, showcase talent of local artists, and add color and interest to business sectors, local attractions, and historical sites. Working with a network of artists and business sponsors, 20 quilts were installed in 2015, and another 20 in 2016. Dave Oaks sealed and installed every single barn quilt, “I had hands on every one of them.”

Today, more than 70 barn quilts have been painted by local artists and are displayed throughout our business corridors and along our country roads. In addition, each of the five cities along the Highway 8 corridor displays an 8-foot barn quilt square.

Special thanks is owed to the Chisago Lakes Area Community Foundation, Dave Oaks, the Chisago County EDA, the cities of Chisago Lakes, more than thirty talented artists, and fifty sponsors. These partnerships brought the barn quilt trail experience to the beautiful backdrop of Chisago Lakes.

Chisago Lakes Road Trip

No matter the time of year, a journey through the Chisago Lakes Barn Quilt Trail offers beautiful experiences and scenery. The Trail is unique in that there are dozens of quilts in such a densely populated area; over 70 quilts can be found within 18 miles!

Each of the cities along the Trail has its own personality, with a variety of things to do that will enhance your exploration of barn quilts. From Interstate State Park in Taylors Falls to the famous Coffee Pot Water Tower in Lindström, your road trip from quilt to quilt will leave you with plenty of memories.

Chisago City

Chisago City is known as the “Gateway to the Lakes,” and home to the western-most quilt square on the trail - located at the world-famous Sven’s Comfort Shoes. Check out more quilt squares (and grab a bite and a pint!) at The Northern Lake Tavern & Grill and Uncommon Loon Brewing Company. Chisago City hosts fifteen parks, including Ojiketa Regional Park (formerly a Campfire Girls camp), a 70-acre, lakeside park.

MHealth Fairview



Lindström

Lindström is known as “America’s Little Sweden” and is one of our most densely populated areas for spotting barn quilts. Enjoy dozens of great shops and eateries along main street while searching for over 30 beautiful quilt squares in our downtown area! Learn more about Swedish heritage and check another quilt square off your list at the Karl Oskar House (Nya Duvemåla) in Ki-Chi-Saga Park.

Center City

Center City was established in 1851 after a Swedish immigrant led 16 settlers through the woods from Taylors Falls to homestead near the pristine lakes of the area. Today, a walk along the Summit Avenue Historic District showcases homes built between 1895 and 1910.

Shafer

Established in 1850, this long-time farming community is a great place to drive backroads while looking for barn quilts. A key segment of the Swedish Immigrant Trail runs through the area and allows you to retrace the metaphorical steps of early settlers. Enjoy a colorful barn quilt, plus apples, pumpkins and bakery treats at Pleasant Valley Orchard, while admiring broad views of the St. Croix Valley. Make sure to stop at Franconia Sculpture Park to take in 50-acres of contemporary sculpture among a restored prairie.

Almelund

Just north of Highway 8 is the agriculture- and heritage-rich town of Almelund. Take in the Apple Festival during the third weekend of September, when the Heritage Center grounds are filled with visitors enjoying ethnic music and dance, homemade apple goods, and tours of original log buildings. Find barn quilts located at the Almelund Mercantile and Amador Town Hall on your way to Wild River State Park. If you visit in early August you can explore the annual Threshing Show and flea market, a huge gathering of steam machine and tractor enthusiasts.

Taylor's Falls

This village on the St. Croix River was established in 1858 and boasts historic charm and stunning scenery. Beginning in the 1830s, immigrants from many countries used this river highway, making Taylor's Falls a "Gateway to Immigration" to the Chisago Lakes area. Explore the historic main street and find quilts at Romayne's Sports Bar & Grill and The Drive In. Finish the Chisago Lakes Barn Quilt Trail with the final quilt, which can be found at Wild Mountain.
